

PARDON ELIGIBILITY

You are eligible for a pardon only if **ALL** the following conditions apply to you:

1. You are seeking a pardon for a **Wisconsin** felony conviction.
2. It has been ***at least 5 years*** since you finished any criminal sentence. This means you:
 - a. Completed all confinement; and
 - b. Completed all supervised release (e.g., probation, parole, or extended supervision)
3. You do not have any pending criminal cases or charges in any jurisdiction.
4. You are not currently required to register as a sex offender.

If you do not meet all the requirements listed above, the Pardon Advisory Board (PAB) will deny your application without a hearing and they will notify you that you are ineligible.

Documents you will need to get to help you fill out the application. These must also be submitted with your application. **You must get certified copies of the following:**

1. **Felony Information**
2. **Criminal Complaint**
3. **Judgement of Conviction**

****Each of these documents has to be certified by the Clerk of Court and that is a \$5.00 fee. Additionally, each page/copy by the Clerk of Courts is \$1.25.****
